Our income for the period May 17th-23rd amounted to **\$3,300** and our expenses for the same period were **\$1,035.05**. Our mail is checked on a daily basis and donations may continue to be mailed to the Parish Office at 45 MacArthur Drive, Scotia. You may also consider checking with your banking institution to set up an automatic bill pay through your online banking. In other financial news, as we try to put together our parish budget for the FYE 6/30/21, your ongoing support of St. Joseph’s is vital. Our line item for “fundraising” took a huge hit in the current fiscal year and will also be affected into the next fiscal year beginning July 1st. If an increase in your weekly offertory is a possibility, we would greatly appreciate it. Rest assured that the Finance Committee is trying to look at any and all options of increased income and/or decrease of expenses.

Included in your set of boxed envelopes is an envelope designated for “**Father’s Day**”. This envelope may be used for a donation in honor or memory of all fathers. During the month of June, these envelopes will be banded together & placed by the statue of St. Joseph in Holy Family Hall.
