

Before our church was closed in March, the Social Concerns Committee was having a **Sock and Food Drive**. We were able to collect **464** pairs of socks which were

delivered to Catholic Charities by Jim & Mary Raymond during our closing. We also accumulated **356** items for the Scotia Food Pantry and have been making regular deliveries to them to help stock their shelves. Thank you to everyone who has helped meet the needs of those less fortunate in our community.



Thank you to those who continued to support St. Joseph's during our closure. Our income for the period June 28<sup>th</sup>-July 3<sup>rd</sup> amounted to \$1,824.00 and

our expenses for the same period were \$1,137.76.
