

As of September 17th, we have \$20,672 in pledges & gifts from 69 parishioners given to this year's Diocesan Appeal (formerly the Bishop's Appeal). St. Joseph's Assessment Goal

The U.S. Catholic Conference of Bishops has an Emergency Disaster Fund that supports the efforts of Catholic Charities USA as well as Catholic Relief Services (these are the official relief services of the Catholic Church). Funds will be used in response to Hurricane Laura & any other disasters that occur and will be distributed where they are most needed. 
