

Just a reminder that the reason we have volunteer ushers to bring you to your seats is to make sure the social distancing is kept and to record where visitors have sat. While each parish may have a different way of keeping track for tracing purposes, most are relying on the help of their volunteers. Please be thankful for these volunteers who are here every week so that we may worship together in a safe environment. The Diocese has started to receive reports of COVID cases at weekend liturgies – now is not the time to let our guard down. Thank you for your ongoing patience and please remember this is not permanent.

Due to the current mass restrictions, it has been decided to postpone our annual Mass of Remembrance that is usually held on All Souls Day. We will keep the Memorial Crosses on the church wall of those who have passed away this past year and will include their names in the mass which will be held in November 2021. We ask that you continue to keep these deceased members of our parish in your prayers.



As of October 9, 2020, **74** families have given **\$23,687** in pledges & gifts to this year's **Diocesan Appeal** (formerly the Bishop's Appeal). St. Joseph's Assessment

Goal is \$60,910 (which is a decrease of \$3,206 from last year). The Appeal will run through June 30, 2021. It should be noted that any amount received in excess of the Parish Assessment Goal will be directed back to the Parish at the end of the Appeal in June 2021.
